- **Spring Season Equipment Update:**
- All equipment has been handed out with the standard package of balls, cones, pinnies, med kits, pump, agility ladders and pop up goals.
- I had to buy some extra med kits as some returned last year had been depleted.
 - I bought 5 more off of Amazon for a total of \$78.
- Every coach has one set of weighted goals and most took a set of non weighted goals (4 total goals).
- A couple coaches took agility poles (older teams) and orange driveway marker poles (younger teams).
- I gave out goalie gloves to those who asked for them.

- We still have a couple of sets available if anyone asks. Size 8 & 7
- **Storage Unit Update:**
- All other equipment is now in our new storage unit at [Vermont Storage and Solar](#)
 - Shout out to Tim for helping me set up payment for this unit and closing out the old one. We are officially out of the North Ferrisburgh Unit.
- We should discuss what we should do with all of the previous year's player shirts (mostly yellow and burgundy colors and youth sizes.

- We are Unit E16, an end unit on the Rte 7 side. Josh, Tim and David have the lock combo, but happy to share with whoever wants it.

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- **Considerations for next year's budget:**
- More pinnies
 - I am finding coaches are asking for a greater mix of different colors.
 - Most were able to get three colors.
 - At the end of handing equipment out, there is a very small amount of pinnies, both youth and adult.
- Additional weighted goals.
 - Some of the goals are aging and replacements are probably a good thing to plan for
 - They are more expensive: \$170 each plus shipping.
- Not many of the orange driveway markers were returned last year.
 - We may want to purchase more based on feedback.
